- The foyer area outside the main symposium venue will be available for the display of posters of innovative research and project work. Already a number of international visitors have indicated that they will be bringing posters of their work.
- Researchers, planners and designers are invited to submit posters and exhibits of recently completed healthcare facility projects. Please use the form for poster registration.
- In order to enable the Committee to arrange for the right amount of display space and number of panels, please return this form no later than 20 May 2007. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee
- Please complete the entry form attached to indicate your interest, willingness to contribute and the projects that you want to exhibit. All consultants may exhibit schemes focussing either on the architectural or engineering aspects (or both). Projects can either be full hospitals, significant upgrades or new buildings on hospital sites. Projects for display should illustrate innovative architectural or engineering planning or design solutions. Only health related projects, such as clinics, hospitals, medical research centres, laundries, etc. will be eligible for display.
- Displays should be prepared as A1 posters which will be mounted in pairs vertically or horizontally on display panels. There will be a maximum of two posters per practice. Displays should include plans, sections and photographs of the scheme together with a brief overview providing background to the project and any special features that were included in the project. The project name, client and full project team should also be provided. Each posters should be supposed to have the symbol of this seminar on the left angle, the size is 10cmX10cm. We will provide the electronic file of the symbol to you.
- Should the Organising Committee consider that the standard of the display material for a particular scheme is not of an acceptable standard as referenced by the majority of work submitted they reserve the right not to display the particular scheme.

- While every endeavour will be made to protect the display panels the Conference Organising Committee will not accept liability for any damages incurred
- It is the responsibility of the team submitting a poster to collect all display material after the exhibition. The Conference Organising Committee will not take responsibility for returning material submitted.
