Medical Architecture has been working exclusively in healthcare design for over 20 years and has been involved in a number of large hospital projects in Australasia since 2008.

Ruairi is an Associate at Medical Architecture, based at the London office where he has worked for 10 years. He has substantial knowledge of healthcare design with a particular focus on concept design and user-group consultation. Recent projects have included Roseberry Park Mental Health Campus in Middlesbrough, Wandsworth Recovery Centre at Springfield Hospital in South London and Ferndene Children and Young Peoples' Centre in Northumberland.

Recent Australian projects by Medical Architecture have included Sunshine Coast University Hospital in Queensland; Royal North Shore Hospital and Northern Beaches Hospital both in New South Wales, and Royal Adelaide Hospital and Glenside Campus Redevelopment in South Australia. Since 2008, Ruairi has led the design of the Glenside project, with time spent in both Adelaide and London. The project is currently under construction and due for completion in 2013.

Ruairi spoke at last year's Design and Health International Conference in Cape Town on 'Social Inclusion and Urban Integration' which focussed primarily on the Glenside Campus Redevelopment.
